

## Waste Services

The building has a designated garbage area located at the rear of the property in the carpark next door to the rear carpark entrance door.

### General Waste - Red Bin

The red lidded bin is for household rubbish and is collected twice a week and taken to landfill.

You should use your red bin to dispose:

- Food
- Plastic bags
- Plastic wrappers
- Foam
- Nappies
- Crokery; and
- Other household rubbish.

### Recycling - Yellow Bin

Your yellow lidded bin is for recyclable items only and is collected once a week. Recyclables are taken to a Materials Recovery Facility (MRF).

You should use your yellow bin to dispose:

- Paper and cardboard
- Plastic bottles, tubs and containers
- Aluminium, steel and aerosol cans
- Glass bottles and jars
- Milk and juice cartons

You can help Recycle Right by:

- Keeping plastic bags out of your yellow bin (plastic bags can only be recycled at participating supermarkets)
- Placing all items in your yellow bin loosely
- Removing lids from bottles, jars and containers
- Emptying liquids and food from bottles, containers and jars first
- Flattening boxes, cartons and bottles to create extra space

## Waste Services

### Household Clean-up Collections

Council provide each unit with 2 pre-booked household clean up collections per year. Bookings are absolutely essential – any items that have been put out without a booking are viewed as illegally dumped rubbish which carries a fine. You can include furniture, metal household appliances, and other household goods in boxes or bags.

You should plan for your collection in advance, as some times, like Christmas, are busier than others.

When you call Council, they will send a letter confirming the date, a brochure with the conditions of collection, and a sticker to put on the materials. You should put materials out the night before and attach the sticker so it is clearly visible.

#### What Council won't collect

- Asbestos and "fibro"
- Insulation batts and fibreglass
- Building and demolition waste (including bricks, concrete, tiles, rocks and soil)
- Cement bags and sawdust
- Oil, paint and other liquids (including empty oil and paint tins)
- Commercial and factory waste
- Motor vehicles, engines and large car parts
- Hazardous materials
- Plate glass or mirrors
- Gas bottles and fire extinguishers
- Food scraps and recyclable materials
- Large, heavy items such as tree stumps and roots
- Materials over 1.5 metres long
- Items that cannot be easily lifted by two people

Unacceptable materials will not be collected and if left out, could lead to a dumped rubbish fine.
